Once nominations has been received students will then be emailed an electronic application form. This will then be processed by the relevant faculty, successful applicants will then receive an offer letter and a student ID number. Incoming students will be emailed additional information to the email address specified in the nomination. 3. Students can apply for accommodation with the student ID number provided to them in their official offer letter

Their application must be accompanied by a letter from their home institution confirming this. If they do not have this cover and or are not able to provide evidence, their application will be rejected.</p> <p><i>Can students combine courses from different faculties?</i></p> <p>Students cannot mix between two Faculties, i.e. Business and French are two different faculties and cannot be combined</p> <p><i>Can students combine courses at bachelor and master level?</i></p> <p>No, unfortunately the two cannot be combined</p> <p><i>What is the minimum and maximum course load?</i></p> <p>Max 120 CAT Credits/year (60 ECTS)</p> <p><i>What are the course requirements?</i></p> <p>B2 Level of English (Equip 6.5 IELTS Score) with minimum 5.5 in every component</p> <p>Some courses/modules may requires pre requisites knowledge and this will be checked by internationalisation teams and the applicants will be informed accordingly</p>

EU students will receive a link for their enrolmmnt prior their departure.</p> <p>For Outgoing students: Coventry University is responsible for monitoring International student’s attendance records on a weekly basis.
